

U-HE FILE CONVERTER QUICK GUIDE

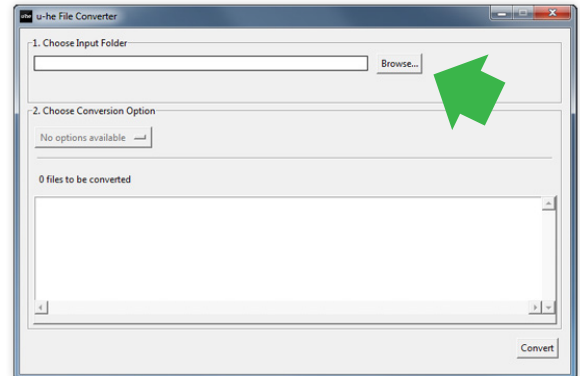
In a few easy steps, the u-he File Converter updates older project files to be compatible with Presswerk 1.1.1 (and future versions). You can read more about [why this conversion is necessary](#).

While the u-he File Converter only modifies copies of your project files—not the originals—please backup your files before proceeding.

1 Choose files to be converted

Click **Browse...** to select a folder containing the project file(s) you want to convert. The u-he File Converter will scan your folders and subfolders for compatible project files.

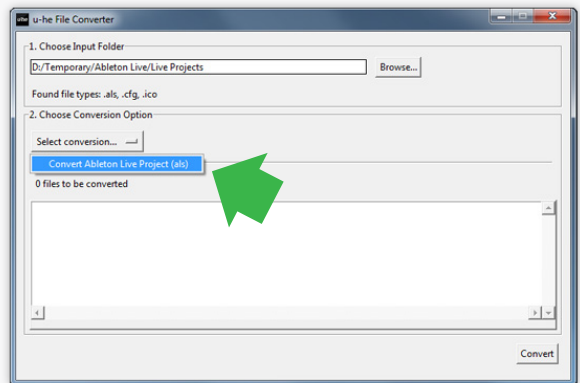
The u-he File Converter supports Steinberg Cubase (.cpr), Cakewalk Sonar (.cwp), Presonus Studio One (.song, .project) and Ableton Live (.als).



2 Choose conversion type

After the input folder is scanned, the **Choose Conversion Options** menu will display a list of options for every compatible DAW file type during the scan in Step 1. Click **Select conversion...** to choose the option you want.

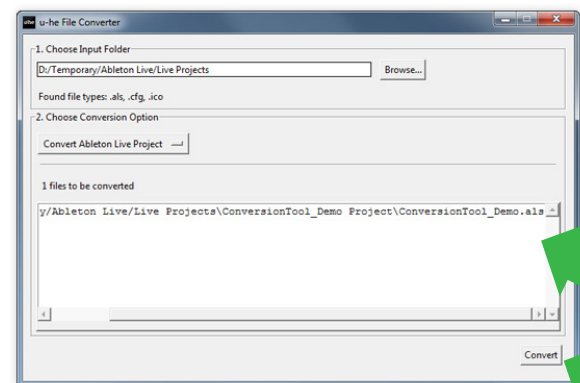
The u-he File Converter will convert one file type at a time, you will need to run the converter for each different DAW project file type you have.



3 Convert the files

After selecting your conversion type, click the **Convert** button. The conversion may take a few minutes depending on how many files there are.

You will see a list of files to be converted in the area above the **Convert** button.



4 Using converted files

You will find the new converted project file in the same folder as the original file. New files have “_converted” added to the end of the name. The original file remains untouched.

You can now open the newly converted files in your DAW, and continue working on your projects with Presswerk.
