

# Zebra Legacy Installation

## How to install Zebra2

Open the '01 Zebra2' folder and run the installer file (Mac Pro Tools users should use the installer in the 'AAX Mac' subfolder instead).

Register your copy by opening a new instance of Zebra2, where you'll be greeted with a grey splash screen. Click on the middle button and enter your name and serial number as they appear in the license email. Alternatively, you can copy/paste the serial number into that field.

Finally, unload and reload Zebra2 to make 100% sure that the registration process is complete.

If you ever lose your Zebra serial number, go to [u-he.com/my-licenses/](https://u-he.com/my-licenses/) , enter the email address to which your u-he licences are registered, and click on *Send License Information*.

## The Dark Zebra / ZebraHZ

The same principle applies here: Open the '02 The Dark Zebra' folder and run the installer file (Mac Pro Tools users should use the installer in the 'AAX Mac' subfolder instead).

ZebraHZ uses the same serial number as Zebra2: Load ZebraHZ, click on the middle button of the grey splash screen, then enter the name and serial number from your Zebra2 license email.

## How to install the soundsets

After installing Zebra2 and ZebraHZ it's time to get those soundsets on board. Here's a general 'how to' video about installing soundsets: [https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TdrmKSVs\\_AE](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TdrmKSVs_AE)

...but to avoid any complications please also read the detailed information below.

### Let's begin!

Open the '03 Zebra Legacy Soundsets' folder which contains all the soundset installers...

## Mac/Win

To install the soundsets on MacOS or Windows, simply open an instance of Zebra2 or ZebraHZ in your host application, then drag & drop each of the *.uhe-soundset* files anywhere within the synth's user interface. Or drag & drop them all at once, which also works!

IMPORTANT: On Windows, dropping *.uhe-soundset* files into ZebraHZ will only work if you also have Zebra2 installed. Only then will the presets be correctly installed in the Zebra2 'User' location, and only then will they appear in ZebraHZ's 'User' subfolder of 'Zebra2'.

If you find that the Zebra window disappears whenever you click outside your DAW, drag the soundset file into your DAW and hold the mouse there for a few seconds: In most cases the Zebra window will reappear and you can drop the file onto it.

## Linux

Currently, drag & drop installation doesn't work on Linux, but you can open Zebra2 or ZebraHZ, click on the u-he badge at the top and select 'Install Soundset'. Then navigate to the location of the *.uhe-soundset* files. Select one and click 'Open' to start the installation process.

## MSEG and OSC presets

Two of the soundsets also include MSEG and OSC (oscillator) presets, which are automatically installed in Zebra2. If you also want to access these in ZebraHZ, you can manually copy them over to ZebraHZ.

Let's do this for the OSC presets first (see page 33 of the ZebraHZ User Guide):

In Zebra2 click on the OSC1 button in the lower bar, then on the OSC MODULE PRESET field. Right-click on Local in the folders area and select 'Show in Finder/Explorer' to open a system window in that location. Do the same for ZebraHZ so you can copy the module presets from one to the other.

Similarly, MSEG presets can be copied over by clicking on one of the MSEG buttons (MSEG1-4 in ZebraHZ) in the lower bar then right-clicking on the preset selector on the left.

## NKS

If the option 'NKS preset files' was selected during your Zebra2 or ZebraHZ installation, we assume that you will also want to include NKS content whenever soundsets are installed. Conversely, if 'NKS preset files' was NOT selected, those files will not be included in soundset installations by default.

NKS users should also make sure they download and install the NKS previews file, a separate download on the Zebra Legacy page <https://u-he.com/products/zebra2/>.

Near the top of that page next to the large black NKS logo there's a download button for NKS previews of all Zebra Legacy soundsets, all in one single file.

After successfully installing these soundsets, NKS users need to rescan the 'Zebra2 Factory' item in *Preferences / Library / Factory* if they don't already appear in the NKS browser on the left.
